When you drop your child at camp, please check this information at the Registration Desk to make sure it is correct and current.**

#### Camp Clothes:

Air or foam mattress  
Pillow

#### Eating Utensils:

\* Please put names on all utensils/dishes

#### Miscellaneous:

Notebook and pencil  
Small flashlight  
Sunscreen  
Bug Spray  
\*Backpack (sufficient for 2-night hike)

\* It is recommended that campers bring an extra day-pack suitable to carry clothing and toiletries required on an overnight hike; with ties to attach a sleeping bag as well for ease of carrying.

### Camp Lone Cloud Halifax Area Camp

- Camp Location:** The Camp is located on an Island in Miller Lake, a little over a mile beyond Waverley and off the main Truro Highway, Rt. 102. The entrance to the camp is off Highway 118, Exit 14 (see sketch map attached).
- Transportation:** Transportation to and from Camp is the responsibility of the parents.
- Arrival:** Campers must arrive at the Mainland Dock of the Camp after 2:00 PM and not later than 3:30 PM on Sunday, the opening day of their camp period. Parents are asked to board the "Clipper," view the Miller's Lake Campsite and complete the sign-in process with their son/daughter. All parents are asked to attend the Opening Ceremonies at 4:00 PM; parents must be off the island by 4:30 PM.
- Departure:** Campers will be taken over to the Mainland Dock on Saturday, the final day of their camp period. To avoid delays campers will be returned to the Mainland Dock by cabin group, which will be assigned on arrival at camp. **Please check with registration on the Island for your departure time.**
- Personal Equipment:** Attached you will find a check list of the equipment that your child will require at Camp. The bunks consist of a solid piece of wood as a sleeping surface. Please ensure that your child brings along an air or foam mattress. You will note this item on the equipment list.
- Important:** **To Avoid the Risk of Injury, Campers are not Permitted to Bring Pocket Knives to Camp. PLEASE DO NOT SEND FOOD, CANDY, POP OR FRUIT. NO PEANUTS OR PRODUCTS CONTAINING NUTS MAY BE BROUGHT ONTO THE ISLAND.**
- Medicines:** If your child requires medication on a daily basis or if there is medication to be kept on hand in case of illness, please indicate this on the application form, and give the medication to the Camp Director, along with written instructions, on arrival at Camp. **PLEASE DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD TO CAMP WITH MEDICINE WITHOUT ADVISING THE CAMP DIRECTOR.**
- Please be aware that for everyone's protection, a head lice check will be performed at site registration.
